

Hot Hotels: Dream Hollywood, LA

One hotel is bringing the glamour back to Hollywood in cutting-edge fashion.

Exuding cinematic glamour back in its 1950s prime, **Hollywood** became a little less chic and a little more shabby in the ensuing years. Now, however, the area has had something of a renaissance, and is home to multiplying spread of shops, restaurants and hotels, including the photogenic, glass-coated **Dream Hollywood**. Joining sister properties in New York and Miami, the Dream towers above the surrounding low-rise landscape, recognizable by its curving windows and enormous logo. Inside, a light-filled lobby is crammed with lush foliage and decked out with pieces by local artists. The 178 rooms have floor-to-ceiling windows and the upper floors offer panoramic views that are topped, literally, by the inevitable rooftop bar, complete with pool, unbroken views of the Hollywood sign, a club called The Lounge at The Highlight Room and a restaurant dishing up Californian fare as healthy or indulgent as you like.
